(2) Men engaged on the Special Admiralty Agreements T. 124 and its variants are not subject to remobilisation.

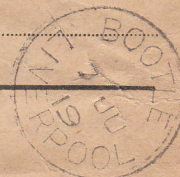

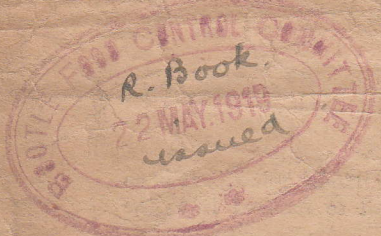

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

1. This certificate is to be retained for two years from the date your leave expires and should be carried in your personal possession whilst on leave of 28 days.
2. You must produce this certificate when you apply at the Employment Exchange for an Unemployed Sailors and Soldiers Donation Policy and, if demanded, when applying for Unemployment benefit.
3. You are to report any change of address to the Mobilising Authority named on the other side hereof, giving the following particulars. (This is not applicable to Mercantile Marine Ratings):—
  - (a) Name and rating.
  - (b) The name of the ship or establishment from which your Protection and Identity Certificate was issued.
  - (c) The number of your Protection and Identity Certificate.
  - (d) Your new address.If you have not received your Service Certificate or all your pay, you should say so when reporting your change of address. The local Post Office in the district which you are leaving should also be informed of your new address.
4. Under the terms of the National Registration (Amendment) Act, 1918, you are required to register yourself within 14 days from the date your leave expires. You should obtain a form for this purpose as soon as possible from the nearest Post Office.
5. If you are taken ill on leave before the date of your discharge you may report in person or otherwise to one of H.M. Ships, a Coast Guard Station, or Recruiting Office if you live near to one, when the visit of a Naval Surgeon and Agent will be arranged. If you do not live near one of these you may (if fit to travel) proceed to the nearest Depot (Plymouth, Chatham or Devonport) or Naval Hospital, for admission for treatment. Take your Protection and Identity Certificate with you. Should you apply to a civil practitioner you will be responsible for his fees; but an allowance towards these fees may be granted under certain conditions as long as you are certified by the civil practitioner as unable to travel, and provided you forward the civil practitioner's certificate at once, with a report of your sickness to your Mobilising Authority.
6. (a) In the event of Mobilisation being ordered, if you are required you will be called up for service by a *personal* calling up summons stating the place at which you are to report, and a Railway Warrant will be sent you. You are to stay where you are until you receive a summons, unless you belonged to the Royal Naval Reserve, in which case see Special Instructions for R.N.R.
  - (b) You are to bring with you when joining on Mobilisation your Service Certificate, R.V. 2 book or T.R.V. 2 book if in your possession, History Sheet, Protection and Identity Certificate, Ration Book (if in use), Registration Card, and Unemployment Policy (if one has been issued to you).
  - (c) You should present yourself in uniform, bringing with you your full kit and bedding, but you must report in any case, whether you are able to appear in uniform or not. Failure to report will render you liable to arrest as an absentee.
  - (d) In the event of Mobilisation being ordered whilst you are absent from the United Kingdom you should report as soon as possible to the nearest British Consul or British Consul.

Additional Instructions applying to Royal Naval Reserve only.

- (A) If you were serving in the ROYAL NAVAL RESERVE, your Registrar will issue an order to you if possible. But whether you get an order from him or not, as soon as you hear that Mobilisation is ordered it will be your duty to report yourself either by letter or in person to the nearest Registrar R.N.R. (Mercantile Marine Office) and ask for instructions.
- (B) On the expiration of two years from the date of this Certificate, if you are then eligible and desire any further discharge certificate from the R.N.R., application should be made (accompanied by this certificate) to the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen through a Mercantile Office for the issue of a formal Certificate of Discharge from the R.N.R. Force.
- (C) R.N.R. men are to report changes of address to the Registrar, R.N.R. of their **HOME DISTRICT**, complying otherwise with the instructions in paragraph 3.
- (D) In the case of sickness you should report to the Registrar, R.N.R., of your **HOME DISTRICT**, complying otherwise with the instructions in paragraph 5.
