A N A G R E E M E N T made the *fourth*
day of *October* One thousand nine hundred and forty
four B E T W E E N THE GOVERNORS AND TRUSTEES OF THE
LIVERPOOL BLUE COAT HOSPITAL (REGISTERED) (hereinafter
called "the Trustees") of the one part and THOMAS CHARLES
HERITAGE M.A. of Woodgarth Beaumaris in the County of
Anglesey Clerk in Holy Orders (hereinafter called "the
Headmaster") of the other part WHEREBY IT IS AGREED as
follows :-

1. THE Trustees HEREBY APPOINT the Headmaster to be the
Headmaster and Chaplain of the Liverpool Blue Coat
Hospital (hereinafter called "the School") as from the
First day of September One thousand nine hundred and forty
four
2. THE salary of the Headmaster shall be Six hundred and
fifty two pounds per annum to be paid to him by monthly
payments on the last day of each month and he shall be
provided with unfurnished residence free of rent rates and
lighting
3. IN consideration of the said appointment and salary
the Headmaster AGREES (a) to act as Headmaster in an
administrative and educational capacity under the direction
of the Trustees (b) to act as Chaplain of the said School
(c) In all respects to observe and act in accordance with
the past traditions of the School and the Decrees and
Orders of the Court under which the School is constituted

4. THIS agreement may be terminated at any time by either of the parties hereto giving to the other of them three months' notice in writing to that effect (such notice if given by the Headmaster to terminate on the last day of the holiday after any school term) _____

5. NOTICE to terminate this agreement shall only be given by the Trustees in pursuance of a resolution (a) passed by a majority of those present at a meeting of the Committee of Management and (b) confirmed at a meeting of the Trustees full notice of which meeting shall be given to the Headmaster and at which he shall be entitled to appear accompanied if he shall so desire by a friend _____

6. (a) IT shall be sufficient that any such notice given by the Trustees shall be signed by the Treasurer on their behalf _____

(b) IT shall be sufficient service of any notice given by the Headmaster if it be addressed to the Treasurer for the time being of the School _____

7. ON termination of this agreement the Headmaster shall deliver up possession of any residence which he may then be occupying and shall be paid a proportionate share of the said salary calculated up to the date of termination of this agreement _____
